

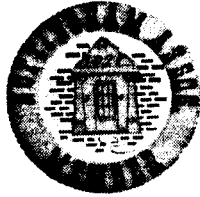

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Residents of Nottingham Park:

The summer is behind us and your Nottingham Association is again preparing to handle the community problems currently approaching us.

Our prime interest at this time is the proposed expansion of the Community Hospital from a relatively small facility to a gigantic complex of buildings that will accommodate 400 beds.

It is the desire of the Nottingham Association to preserve the character and environment of this fine area, and we therefore invited all residents, members as well as non-members, to come and voice their opinion and take an active part in this decision making meeting.

An open meeting is scheduled for Thursday, September 23, 1971, 8:00 P.M., to hear the hospital's representatives proposal. In addition we will have important officials from the Health and Hospital Planning Council of Southern New York, and officials from the New York State Department of Health, and other representatives from the State of New York.

It is our understanding that these officials will make recommendations and decisions on this proposed expansion as a result of the residents' views.

The Board of Directors of Nottingham Association cannot assume this responsibility without hearing the views of the residents of the entire community.

We urgently request the cooperation of all members and non-members residing in our community.
